NHS Derby and Derbyshire ICB Position Statement: Vaginal Pessaries

Statement

NHS Derby and Derbyshire ICB will commission the initial insertion of a ring pessary in Secondary Care for the non-surgical repair of vaginal prolapse.

Patients should be discharged to Primary Care for ongoing management and follow up for the pessary when clinically appropriate.

These commissioning intentions will be reviewed periodically. This is to ensure affordability against other services commissioned by the ICB.

Rationale

The intention of this position statement is to ensure that the majority of pessaries are fitted within a Primary Care setting.
